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**POLICY:**

Cases which were previously referred to and enforced as “interstate” cases will now be handled in accordance with OCSE Action Transmittal 10-06, and will be referred to as “intergovernmental” cases.

**DEFINITIONS:**

IV-D: Refers to section IV-D of the Social Security Act.

Intergovernmental IV-D Case: A IV-D case in which the noncustodial parent lives and/or works in a different jurisdiction than the custodial parent and child(ren) that has been referred by an initiating agency to a responding agency for services. An intergovernmental IV-D case may include any combination of referrals between states, tribes, and countries. An intergovernmental IV-D case also may include cases in which a state agency is seeking only to collect support arrearages, whether owed to the family or assigned to the State.
